

The Birth of Brunswick County

On March 9, 1764, the Governor of North Carolina signed the legislative act that created Brunswick County out of New Hanover and Bladen Counties. The county was named after the Town of Brunswick, which was named in honor of the Duke of Brunswick and Lunenberg, King George I.

BRUNSWICK, Duchy of. Quarterly: 1 or, semee of hearts gules, a lion rampant azure (Luneberg), 2 gules, two lions passant crowned gules (Everstein), 4 gules, a lion rampant or within a bordure compony argent and azure (Homburg), 5 or, a lion rampant gules, crowned azure, 6 gules, three bars and in chief a lion in base per fesse in chief barry of four gules and argent (New Bruchhausen), the base gyronny of eight argent and azure (Old Bruchhausen), 8 azure, an eagle displayed argent; armed gules (Diepholz), 9 barry of four argent and gules, a pale counterchanged (Hohnstein), 10 argent, a stag's attire gules (Reinstein), stag's attire sable (Blankenburg). Supporters—Two savages, each supporting a club and wreathed about the head and middle with leaves. Motto—"Nec aspera terrent."

The County Seat

The County Seat was first located at Brunswick Town.

1779 — County Seat was moved to Lockwood's Folly

1808—County Seat was moved to Smithville (Smithville's name was changed to Southport in 1887.

1975—On July 19, a referendum passed moving the County Seat from Southport to its present location just below the Town of Bolivia.

The new County Seal was adopted on December 15, 1975 by the Brunswick County Board of Commissioners.

The symbols represent the four primary industries in Brunswick County at the time of adoption: Tourism, Industry, Seafood, and Farming.





Brunswick Nature Park

Location: The Brunswick Nature Park is located on River Road (NC 133) in Town Creek Township, NC about 10 miles from Leland, NC.

Amenities: Brunswick Nature Park consists of 911 acres of wonderful undeveloped wilderness that provides a dynamic mix of vegetation, wildlife, ecosystems, vistas, wetlands, and waterways. It is truly an environmental oasis worthy of exploration. You can enjoy our new kayak/canoe launch site, 40 ft. by 40 ft. picnic pavilion* perfect for a family gathering, and a small fishing pier. This park is open from dawn until dusk.

Brunswick River Park

Location: 580 River Road in Leland, NC 28451. Located directly across from Belville Elementary School.

Amenities: Brunswick River Park consists of 22 acres. There is a viewing dock overlooking the Brunswick River as well as three picnic shelters, two playgrounds, a restroom facility, and areas for you to go fishing.

Cedar Grove Park

Location: 750 Grove Trail Southwest, Supply, NC 28462 **Amenities:** Cedar Grove Park is the newest addition to Brunswick County Parks. Located convenient to Supply, Shallotte, and Holden Beach, NC this park offers opportunities to enjoy nature, play, and have fun. This park is located directly behind Cedar Grove Middle School and is essential to the school as the school's main practice and leisure grounds.

Dutchman Creek Park

Northwest District Park

Location: 1937 Andrew Jackson Highway, NE Leland, NC 28451 **Amenities:** Northwest District Park consists of 35 acres featuring five baseball/ softball fields (two at 300 ft., one at 250 ft., one at 200 ft., and one at 150 ft.), a concession stand with restrooms, two basketball courts, four tennis courts, four picnic shelters*, a playground, and eight acres of practice area.

Ocean Isle Beach Park

Location: 6483 Old Georgetown Rd, Ocean Isle Beach, NC 28469
Ocean Isle Beach is located on Old Georgetown Road in Ocean Isle Beach.

Amenities: Ocean Isle Beach Park consists of 58 acres with two playgrounds, eight tennis courts, an amphitheater*, a restroom facility, a picnic shelter*, and a multipurpose field which will be used for football, soccer, and much more.

Smithville District Park
